
Easter will be here before we know it. Many of us have started making plans for Easter lunch and preparing for visits from the Easter bunny, but don't hop ahead too far just yet. There are still a few stops along the way to the cross. We typically celebrate the Sunday before Easter as Palm Sunday, but it is also known as Passion Sunday. I served in four churches prior to Calvary, and only one celebrated the Sunday before Easter as both Palm Sunday and Passion Sunday. The other three celebrated it only as Palm Sunday. I can understand why. It is fun to celebrate with waving palms and shouts of "Hosanna!" But celebrating both Palm and Passion Sunday forces us to look at the stark reality: Jesus did not enter Jerusalem for a big party; it was his path to the cross. We must walk that path with Jesus through Holy Week. We cannot skip from the joy of Palm Sunday right to the joy of Easter without first sitting beside Jesus at the Last Supper, falling asleep in the garden when he asks us to stay awake and pray, fleeing when he is arrested, denying that we know him, watching him suffer and die on the cross, and dwelling in the dark tomb.


We know the joy that awaits us as Christ is resurrected from the dead, but do not rush ahead. Take one step at a time through Holy Week. Feel the weight of Holy Week, the impact it has. If we are willing to look upon the suffering of Christ, it has the potential to soften our hearts and open our eyes to see the suffering of those around us. May God lead us through Holy Week and into the world to share God's love, hope, and grace.




Brenda Davis and Brenda Johnson will be retiring from their preschool positions after serving our preschool school for over 30 years.
