The journey through Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is March 5th this year. Advent and Lent are two seasons in the church year where we prepare ourselves for significant moments in the life of Jesus Christ. The journey through Lent is introspective, following the path of Jesus as he made his way to the cross. Lent has the capacity to feel somber and barren, particularly when we consider that Lent begins with the reminder that we are dust, and to dust we shall return.

The inner feelings of Lent match the season of nature it starts in. Lent begins in the cold days of winter, when the trees are bare, and snow covers the ground. The days are still shorter, the nights are longer and darker. And yet, as we move through Lent, the earth makes way for spring. Buds begin to form on the trees and flowers start blooming. The days become longer and have more sunlight. New life begins to spring up around us.

Lent is a season of prayer, fasting, and repentance. Many of us give something up for Lent, such as coffee, chocolate, watching TV, etc. as a means of spiritual sacrifice and mirroring Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the wilderness. The intention is to demonstrate self-discipline and focus on our relationship with God, temporarily denying ourselves a pleasure or indulgence. But what if instead of giving something up, we cultivated something new?

Our Lenten sermon series is called "Cultivate." As we journey through Lent, we will focus on cultivating practices and heart postures that lead us closer to God. Following the transition from winter to spring, we will nurture our spiritual growth so that new life will emerge within and around us, as we blossom into who God created us to be.




Thursday, March 6 6:00 pm Come join us for a time of fellowship.
